**Captain John Tyson  
On Furlough Here**

Captain John L. Tyson, son of Mrs. J. R. Tyson, Bethlehem, R. D. 3, is spending a furlough visiting his mother, Josephine Tyson, and his son, John L. Tyson Jr., at his mother's home. Holder of the Distinguished Flying Cross, the Air Medal and three battle stars, Captain Tyson has not been home for 13 months. This marks his first meeting with his son.

Captain Tyson entered the service October 4, 1941, with the rank of second lieutenant. A graduate of Allentown Prep., he attended Bucknell University and Muhlenberg College. He is due at Greensboro, N. C., on January 6, 1946.
