## Sgt. Muschlitz Reported As War Victim

Mrs. Edward Muschlitz, 645 Alaska Street, the former Sarah E. Baringer, received word from the War Department that her husband, Staff Sgt. Edward M. Muschlitz, was killed in action, October 4, in Germany.

Sgt. Muschlitz was inducted into the armed forces April 22, 1942. He was in the 41st Armored Infantry and received his training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and Fort Bragg, N. C. He was sent overseas in October, 1942, and participated in the African and Sicilian campaigns. He was then sent to England for further training and from there to France.

Besides his wife, Sgt. Muschlitz is survived by two sisters, Mrs. William Ferency and Mrs. Richard Kester, both of Bethlehem.

Before entering the service he was employed by the Bethlehem Setel Company.

October 27, 1944
