**Navy Father With 3 Sons
In Army Presumed Dead**

Official notice was received Friday by Mrs. Samuel Bromall, 158 Lawn Avenue, Sellersville, that her husband, Samuel Bromall, chief metalsmith on the transport USS George T. Elliot, which was sunk Aug. 8, 1942, off Guadalcanal, was missing in action and is presumed to be dead.

The 49-year-old sailor is the father of three sons and a daughter, and was recalled from Naval retirement at the start of the war.

His three sons are all in the Army. They are: Pvt. Samuel Bromall, stationed at Aberdeen, Md.; Cpl. Harry Bromall, stationed in Louisiana, and Cpl. William Bromall, somewhere in Africa. His daughter, Isabel Bromall is employed at the Bell Telephone Company, Swarthmore.
