Sherwood Ashenfelder Ends Navy Service

Sherwood H. Ashenfelder, son of Mr. and Mrs. Earl Ashenfelder of Daniels Slate Quarry, has received his discharge from the Navy after two years and seven months service.

Ashenfelder was inducted in Allentown, November 19, 1943, and received his "boot" training at Newport, R. I. He was then transferred to Storekeepers' school in Boston, where he graduated as Storekeeper Second Class.

On September 10, 1944, he went overseas to serve at the headquarters of Admiral Kirk in Paris, serving there until November 28, 1945. He was discharged May 20, 1946, at Bainbridge, Md.
