Pfc. Raymond Stoudt Slightly Wounded

Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Stoudt, South Broad Street, Nazareth, received word from the War Department that their son, Pfc. Raymond Stoudt, has been reported slightly wounded in action in Belgium on January 3.

Pfc. Stoudt had formerly been reported missing in action on July 8, 1944, when he was lost for eight days. He entered the army on April 22, 1943, and received training at Camp Joseph Robinson, Arkansas; Fort Benning, Ga., and Fort Meade, Md. He attended Nazareth High School and was a former employe of the Nazareth Paper Box Company.
