Herbert R. Frye Completes Basic Course

Herbert R. Frye, who will be remembered as a member of the staff of inspectors of the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry, as well as for his activities in Northampton County during the early days of the Civilian Defense set-up development, has completed his basic training at the Red River Ordnance Depot of the U. S. Army, Texarkana, Texas, and is now rated acting first sergeant.

Sgt. Frye, who is attached as staff sergeant to a training squadron at Sheppard Field, Texas, has qualified as a marksman on the rifle range and it was while serving with the ordnance depot company on bivouac that his outstanding ability was recognized by his commanding officers and he was transferred to Red River for special work.

He was assigned to the Air Corps on July 31 on the special recommendation of General H. "Haps" Arnold, chief of the AAF, and will shortly be classified and sent to another center for intensified training.
