**Cpl. Earl Brittain,
East Bangor, Gets
Army Discharge**

Cpl. Earl Brittain, son of Mr. and Mrs. Herbert Brittain, Central Avenue, East Bangor, is the first East Bangor soldier to be discharged under the new point plan.

He is now at Fort Dix, from where he will be discharged.

Cpl. Brittain enlisted August 1, 1940 and was serving at Schofield Barracks, Pearl Harbor, on December 7, 1941, when the Japs attacked. He was also in Australia, New Guinea and the Philippines and participated in the invasions of Hollandia and Leyte. After a 30-day furlough, he was sent to Fort Ord, Cal., where he was stationed for several months.
