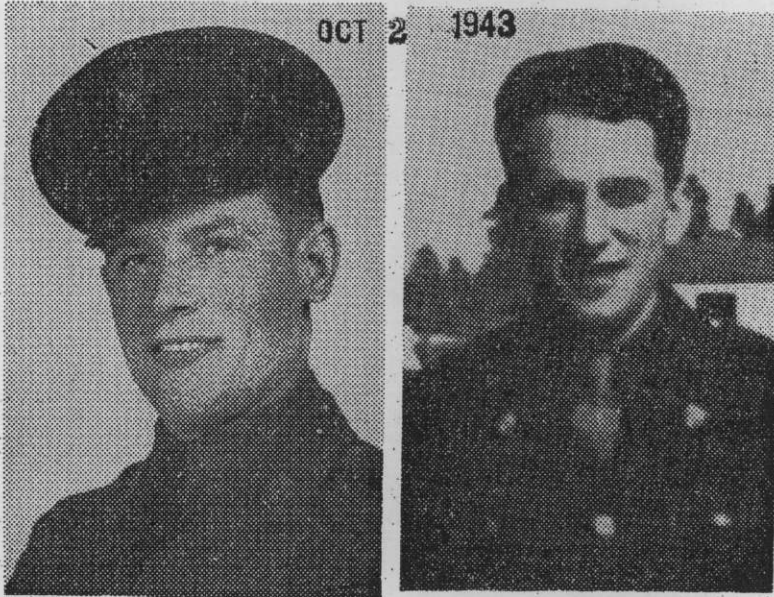


Marinsky, John
