Promoted Overseas



John Goor, veteran of battles in North Africa, Tunisia, Sicily, and Italy and now in England getting a well-earned respite from combat duty, now sports the three chevrons of a sergeant, he wrote this week to his brother and sister-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Louis Goor, 1811 East Fourth Street, with whom he had resided before entering the service. Sgt. Goor was inducted in February of 1942 and trained at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and other centers. He was sent overseas in October of the same year from Indiantown Gap. During the course of the battles in which he was engaged as an infantryman, he was slightly wounded in the Tunisian action. He is a former bartender at the Hotel Washington and today is his birthday, his 23rd. The photograph was sent from England.
