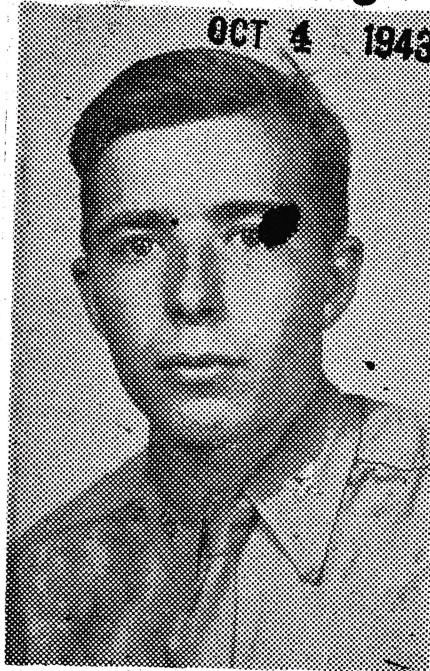


Reslie, William J.
