**Petty Officer Vollman
Home On Leave**

Donald Hay Vollman, Storekeeper, 2/C Petty Officer, was recently home on a short leave with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Vollman, 747 Hawthorne Road.

Petty Officer Vollman enlisted in the Navy February 22, 1942 and took his training at Sampson, N. Y. From there, he was assigned to the Monterey, aircraft carrier, where he has been serving for two years.

The Monterey, on which Vollman is still serving, transporting men back home from Europe, is called "Queen of the Navy" and took part in twelve major Pacific battles.

Storekeeper 2/C Vollman took part in the Navy Day celebration aboard the Monterey on the Hudson River in New York City, and received one of his biggest thrills, saluting President Truman as he went by aboard the USS Renshaw.

November 6, 1945
