George Deisinger, 41, Seaman 1/C, a former resident of Bethlehem, lost his life when an American submarine sank a Jap prison ship. This information was received by his sister, Mrs. Theresa Kramer, New York City, who notified friends in this city.

A son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Michael Deisinger, he resided with his family on East Sixth Street, near Monroe, before establishing a residence in New York City. He enlisted in the Navy in 1926, and was taken prisoner by the Japs.
