Cannoneer Back From War Fronts

Elwood H. Strohl, son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Strohl, 1413 Center Street, arrived at the Valley Forge General Hospital, Phoenixville, Pa., November 21, after serving as a cannoneer in England, France, Belgium, Luxemburg and Germany.

Pvt. Strohl, attached to the Field Artillery, was inducted in Allentown, April, 1943 and wears the European theater of operations campaign ribbon. Prior to his induction he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.

When asked how it feels to be back home again he replied, "Heaven." He is being treated for a broken eardrum received in France from the concussion of our 155 howitzers. A brother, Pvt. Robert Strohl, is serving somewhere in France with the infantry.
