Robert Nicholas Ditterline, son of Roy Ditterline, Sr., 256 West Elizabeth Avenue, was commissioned an Ensign in the Naval Reserve and designated a Naval Aviator recently at the Naval Air Training Bases, Pensacola, Fla.

Ensign Ditterline enlisted in Philadelphia, December, 1942, and was sent to the University of Pennsylvania for training. He was then sent to Westminster College, Wilmington, Pa.; Chapel Hill, N. C., for intensive physical training; Bunker Hill Field, Peru, Ind., for primary training, and on to Pensacola. He is a graduate of Bethlehem High School, where he was a member of the School Band and a former employee of the Bethlehem Construction Company.

Having completed his intermediate training at the "Annapolis of the Air," the young officer will be ordered to duty either at an instructor's school for further training or at an operational base at the completion of his leave.

Robert Ditterline's brother, Roy E. Ditterline, was recently commissioned in the Air Corps.
