Lieut. Col. Lindner and an older brother, Staff Sergeant George Lindner, stationed in Paris, France, at present, met somewhere in Germany a few months ago. Another brother, Earl, is stationed with an Infantry Intelligence and Reconnaissance Company at Camp Blanding, Florida.
