Missing In Action

Mrs. Amandus G. Schaffer, 1927 West Broad Street, received a telegram from the War Department yesterday informing her that her husband, Pfc. Amandus G. Schaffer is missing in action since December 12, 1944, in France and that when further details or other information is received, she will be promptly notified. Pfc. Schaffer was with General G. S. Patton's Third Army. He entered the service in March, 1944, and after receiving infantry training at Camp Blanding, Fla., was sent overseas in September. His only brother, Pfc. Donald R. Schaffer, was the first Bethlehem boy to give his life in this war on November 10, 1942. Their father, Robert N. Schaffer, resides at 414 West Broad Street.
