After Pacific Duty**

Sgt. Lawrence Woodley, son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Woodley, 122 East Garrison Street, Bethlehem, has been given an honorable discharge from the Army because of physical disability, it was announced by the Separation Center, Moore General Hospital, Swannanoa, N. C. He served in the Asiatic Pacific with the Infantry, 41st Division ("Jungleers").
