## Sgt. John Henn War Victim In Germany

"The Secretary of War desires me to express his deep regret that your son, Sergeant John L. Henn, was killed in action in Germany March 19."

The above wire was received last evening by Mr. and Mrs. Morris Maczek, of 648 Buchanan Street, step-father and mother of the young man who was serving as a tank driver with the 12th Armored Division of the Seventh Army.

Sgt. Henn entered the armed forces December 28, 1942, and left last September for overseas duty, serving in England, France and Germany. A former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company, he was 22 years old at the time of his death.

In addition to his mother and step-father, Sgt. Henn is survived by three sisters and a brother: Mrs.

John Posivak, Mrs. George Olexa and Mrs. John Horninger, all of Bethlehem, and Joseph, of Fountain Hill. Memorial services will be arranged at a later date.
