**Three Local Men
Now Paratroopers** ^{JAN 3} 1944

Three Bethlehem men have won the right to wear the world famous wings and boots of the United States Army Volunteer Paratrooper, World War II's most feared warrior. They made their fifth and qualifying jumps, night tactical leaps, identical to actual combat work in Sicily, at Fort Benning, Ga.
