Ends Furlough 2 1945

Cpl. Thomas J. Snyder, son of Mr. and Mrs. Alfred J. Snyder, 1701 Broadway, completed a 17-day delay-enroute furlough with his parents, and returned to Westover Field, Mass., for further training.

Cpl. Snyder was inducted February 6, 1942; receiving his basic training at Camp Pickett, Va., and was transferred to Keesler Field, Miss. After graduating there from the technical school, he attended the Willow Run B-24 Bomber School, Michigan. Upon completion of training there, he was sent to Tyndall Field Gunnery School, Fla., where he received his wings.

Prior to entering the service, he attended Muhlenberg College, where he was a member of the Alpha Tau Omega fraternity. He is a graduate of Bethlehem High School and St. Ursula Parochial School.
