**Northampton Physician
Now Lieut.-Commander**

Promotion from lieutenant senior grade to lieutenant commander has recently been announced for Dr. Myles R. Miller, who before enlisting in the U. S. Navy was a practising physician in Northampton.

Lieut. Commander Miller became a lieutenant junior grade in the Navy a year before the outbreak of the war. After serving at Parris Island, S. C., Norfolk, Va., and Miami, Fla., where he became a flight surgeon, he was sent to British Guiana.

After service in the Navy's jungle air base in British Guiana where he was chief medical officer for a year, he was recalled to the states and is

now stationed at the Navy's new inland base at Memphis, Tenn.
