Taken ill this morning shortly after 7 o'clock, Mrs. Margaret Loretta (Courtney) Reagan, wife of John Reagan, 227 East Fifth Street, died within an hour, according to an investigation by Dr. D. F. Bachman, Coroner of Northampton County. He issued a certificate of death ascribing a heart ailment as the cause.

A lifelong resident of Bethlehem, she was a daughter of the late John and Anna Courtney. She was a member of Holy Infancy Church and was affiliated with the Altar and Rosary Society.

Besides her husband she is survived by the following children: William, Joseph, Francis, James, Margaret and Anna Reagan, at home; Leo, U. S. Navy, stationed "somewhere in the Pacific Ocean"; John, Fountain Hill; Mrs. Carl Napravnik, Bethlehem, and Mrs. Joseph Gaffney, Philadelphia. Two brothers, John Bethlehem, and Patrick, Philadelphia; two sisters, Nellie Courtney, Bethlehem, and Mrs. Joseph Mellon, Bethlehem, and eight grandchildren also survive.
