**Sgt. Patsy Verona,

Word of the death of Sgt. Patsy Verona, 25-year-old West Bangor infantryman, was confirmed in a telegram from the War Department received this morning by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Gus Verona. Previous news of the death of the young soldier on Leyte December 2 came in a letter from a soldier friend of Verona sent to a West Bangor man.

Sgt. Verona entered service three years ago and prior to that time had been employed by Imperial Shirt Company, West Bangor. He was a member of St. Joseph's Episcopal Church, West Bangor, and was active in baseball circles in the area.

In addition to his parents, the following brothers and sisters survive: Charles, U. S. Army in Africa; Lena, Louis, Mammie, Nicholas and Gus, Jr., of West Bangor. Nicholas will leave for service this month.
