Nazareth Man Wounded, Wife Is Informed

Pfc. John F. Mucha, 25, husband of the former Louise V. Greenleaf, 317 Woodfield Street, Nazareth, and son of Mr. and Mrs. John Mucha, of the same address, was seriously wounded in action in Germany on Dec. 16, according to word received by his family.

Pfc. Mucha was hospitalized in Belgium and was later sent to France. Mrs. Mucha was given the opportunity to send her husband a radiogram, consisting of five cheerful words, at the expense of the War Department.

Pfc. Mucha entered the service in December, 1943, received training at Camp Walters in Texas, and at Fort Meade, Maryland. He was sent overseas in June, 1944, and after a few weeks in England, was shipped to France, also seeing action in Belgium and Germany.

Prior to entering the service, Mucha was in the employ of the Nazareth Cement Corporation.
