Second Lieutenant Paul Strohl, 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. Milton Strohl, 2136 Lincoln Avenue, Northampton, who is a navigator on a Flying Fortress, has been awarded the Air Medal at the 8th AAF base in England. The presentation was made by Group Commander Hunter Harris, Jr., of Athens, Ga.

Before entering the service in September, 1942, Lt. Strohl was a student at Temple University. He received his navigator's wings in February, 1944, at San Marcos, Texas.

The official citation read: "For exceptionally meritorious achievement while participating in bomber missions over enemy occupied Continental Europe. The courage, coolness and skill displayed by Lieutenant Strohl upon these occasions reflect great credit upon himself and the Armed Forces of the United States."
