Mrs. Thomas Parent Sr., of Mauch Chunk Road, received a telegram from the War Department, informing her that her husband, Pfc. Thomas Parent Sr., who is serving with the Quartermaster Corps, was injured in action in France, July 29.

Pfc. Parent entered the service December 18, 1943; and received his training at camps in Virginia and New Jersey. In May, 1944, he was sent overseas to England and later to France where he is now stationed.

According to a letter received just recently, Pfc. Parent states that he received the Purple Heart and that he is recovering nicely.
