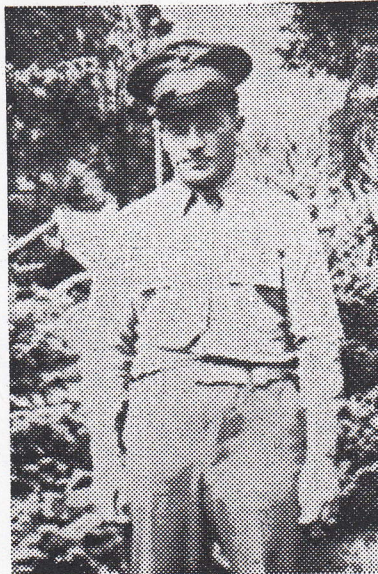

## Local Man, Fifth Marine To Land In Guadalcanal

In a letter received yesterday, Marine Steve Shivek, son of Mrs. Eva Toth, Bethlehem R. D. 4, announces his promotion from private first class to corporal. Cpl. Shivek was the fifth man to land on Guadalcanal, coming ashore in the first landing barge.

He saw action on the island for six months, before being invalided to Australia for five months with malaria. The Marine is now at Indian Island, Hadlock, Wash. A Globe-Times carrier since the age of nine, Cpl. Shivek later worked for Bethlehem Steel Company.

He is now serving his second hitch in the marines, his first enlistment lasting from 1934-38. On Jan. 20, 1941, after the Jap sneak attack, he re-enlisted, and was sent to Parris Island for boot training.

He arrived in California in June, and had a 30-day leave in July, which he spent here. He hopes to get home for Christmas.

Two brothers are also serving in the Marines, both of them privates. Louis is going to school in Richmond, Va., and Alex is taking boot training at Parris Island.
