Now A Paratrooper 1944

FORT BENNING, Ga.—Pvt. Joseph Vuchak, son of Mrs. Mary Toth, 1507 Jeter Avenue, Bethlehem, Pa., has won the right to wear the world-famous wings and boots of the United States Army Volunteer Paratrooper, World War II's most feared warrior. He made his fifth and qualifying jump, a night tactical leap identical to actual combat work in Sicily, which completed his four weeks of jump training.
