Word has been received by Mrs. Michael Kraynick, Northampton, that her husband, 2nd Lieutenant Michael Kraynick, had been promoted to 1st Lieut. recently. Lt. Kraynick received basic training at Fort Eustis, Va., after which he was sent to Porto Rico for 7 months. He returned to the U. S. to attend O. C. S. at Fort Benning, Ga., where he was commissioned a Second Lieutenant, December 2, 1942.

After his marriage to the former Katherine Kokolus they resided in Washington, D. C., till he was transferred to the Censorship detachment, New York City, for 3 months. He was then assigned to Military Intelligence School, Camp Ritchie, Md.

Lt. Kraynick returned overseas December 27, 1943, and is now serving in Cairo, Egypt. There he toured the Holy Land, seeing such historic places as Bethlehem, Palestine and Jerusalem.
