Hurt In Action

Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Pasco, 1533 East Second Street, received a War Department telegram informing them that their son, Private First Class Edward J. Pasco, had been seriously wounded in France, November 26, 1944. The telegram was followed by a card from a hospital in England which reported his condition as being greatly improved. Pfc. Pasco enlisted the day after Pearl Harbor in 1941. He completed his training at Fort Bragg, N. C.; Pine Camp, N. J.; and Los Angeles, Calif., before going overseas last December. He is a member of the Armored Division. His uncle, Pvt. Edward Stalcoskie, was reported killed in action in France a few months ago.
