Honorably Discharged Officer, Recalled to Duty, Now Non-Com

MOSES LAKE, Wash. — Again climbing the ladder of promotions, Private Lloyd A. Fatzinger, son of Mr. and Mrs. James A. Fatzinger, of 1056 Jeter Avenue, Bethlehem, now stationed at Moses Lake Army airfield was recently promoted to the rank of corporal.

Skipping the grade of private first class, the new rank is not quite so high as the one he held until October of last year. Originally inducted July 9, 1942, Fatzinger attended

anti-aircraft OCS and was graduated December 31, 1942. He served as second lieutenant in the anti-aircraft artillery until Oct. 2, 1943, when he was honorably discharged.

However, he was recalled to active duty December 9, 1943, as a private. Shortly afterward he was stationed at Hammer Field, near Fresno, Calif., and was transferred to this Fourth Air Force post in April of this year.

He is assigned to duty in the orderly rooms of Squadron D.
