

Lt.-Col. Kissner Assigned To Berlin Staff

Lt.-Col. Franklin H. Kissner, formerly on duty with the Army Air Forces Headquarters in Washington, D. C., has been assigned to duty with the United States Group of the Allied Control Council for Germany, located in Berlin.

Col. Kissner will serve on the staff of General William H. Draper, assistant deputy of the Council for Resources. His work will consist of staff duties incident to the formation of industrial and economic policies to be followed in controlling Germany during the post-surrender period.

He was graduated from Liberty High School as salutatorian in 1926. He graduated from Harvard University in 1930 and was awarded the Mary Saltonstall Scholarship to Europe, where he studied at Oxford, England and Sorbonne, France. Lt.-Col. Kissner is a former employe of the Price Waterhouse Company, Pittsburgh. His mother, Mrs. Emily Kissner, resides at 701 New Street.
