Bath Soldier Reported Hurt In Germany

Word was received from the War Department at Washington that Clarence E. Miller, husband of Evelyn Miller, Bath, R. F. D. No. 1, was slightly injured in action in Germany Dec 14th. The message stated reports of condition will be forwarded as received. Miller entered the service the 29th of April, 1944, and received his basic training at Camp Blanding, Fla., in the infantry. He was home last in early October. He is the father of one three-year-old daughter.

Word was received from the Government at Washington Sunday that Joseph W. Dlugos, son of Mr. and Mrs. John and Victoria Dlugos, Bath, R. F. D. No. 2, who was injured in action in France early in November, was able to return to his unit as of Dec. 7th.
