Sibylle Rettenmaier, born in Heubach, Germany is a painter and a sculptor who has been creating art for the past sixteen years. Since 1988, her work has been exhibited throughout Germany and in 2001, she completed the second of two large stainless steel sculptures commissioned by the city of Schwaebisch Gmuend. Her work is part of the permanent collection of the Reinhold Wuerth Museum in Kuenelsau, Germany.

Sibylle is a self taught artist who describes her work as "spontaneous and created with strong emotion."

Whether she paints people, places or abstract compositions, the source of her work is the emotion she releases "from inside her heart and her soul."

Prior to working as an independent artist for the past two years, Sibylle was a florist, owned a restaurant and recreated formerly used furniture. Her studio is in Schwaebisch Gmuend, Germany.
