### **Cpl. James A. Brown Assigned to Famous Army Air Squadron**

Cpl. James A. Brown, son of Mrs. James Ruth, 39 West Ettwein Street, has been assigned to one of the Army Air Forces most famous units, the 375th Bombardment Group.

This much decorated unit, commanded by Col. Warren Yankton, flew B-24 Liberators on 452 long-range combat missions in the Middle East, North Africa and Europe. Now the unit is training with B-29 Superfortresses at Grand Island Army Air Field, Nebraska.

After graduation from high school, Cpl. Brown became a steel worker in the mills of the Bethlehem Steel Company. He entered the air forces at Allentown July 11, 1942. Having attended aviation mechanics school, and aircraft factory school, Cpl. Brown is now assigned to duty as an engine mechanic.
