Staff Sergeant William T. Jones Jr., recently returned from England, where he was assigned to Gen. Jimmy Doolittle's Eighth Air Force and awarded the Air Medal, three Oak Leaf Clusters, two Citations, and a Presidential Citation.

Jones completed 29 missions over France and Germany in both Flying Fortresses and Liberator bombers, serving as a gunner and mechanic. He was also the crew artist, having painted their mascot, "Cokey Flo," a scantily clad miss with a monkey wrench in one hand and a four leaf clover in the other, on their planes' side.
