## Twice Wounded



Mrs. Reading Crouthamel, Easton R. D. 4, formerly of Bethlehem, received word from the War Department that her son, Cpl. Norman A. Otto, was slightly wounded in action in Luxembourg on January 18. He had been previously wounded on September 18, 1944, at which time he received the Purple Heart. Cpl. Otto was inducted into the Army April 5, 1943, and received training at Camp Campbell, Ky., after which he went on maneuvers in Tennessee and then was sent to Camp Phillips, Kan. On April 30, 1944, he was sent overseas and is now serving with the Third Tank Division.
