A telegram was received yesterday by Mr. and Mrs. George R. Hahn Sr. of 861 North Hofert Street containing the news that their son, Pfc. George R. Hahn Jr., was slightly wounded in action in Germany and is now recuperating in a hospital there. The young man, a member of St. Ursula's Catholic Church, was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company before entering the armed forces. He was inducted December 9, 1943. At the completion of training at Camp Blanding, Fla., Camp Butner, N. C., and Camp Atterbury, Ind., he was shipped overseas in September of 1944.
