**Pfc. Melville Kuhns
Suffers War Wounds**

Pfc. Melville R. Kuhns, fighting with Lieut. Gen. George S. Patton's Third Army in Luxembourg, was wounded in action on December 24, according to information received by his mother, Mrs. Florence Kuhns of 706 Lechauweki Avenue, Fountain Hill. He is presently recuperating in a hospital in Paris.

A graduate of Liberty High School, class of 1936, he was inducted into the armed forces on April 26, 1944, and following training at Camp Croft, S. C., was sent overseas in October. He is a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company. A brother, Sergeant Charles Kuhns, is stationed at Baer Field, Fort Wayne, Indiana.
