Kenneth W. Kachline, MOMM 2/C, U. S. Navy, re-ceived the Bronze Star Medal in a ceremony at the U. S. Naval Base, Okinawa. He was on the staff of the Commander of the Seventh Amphibious Force during oper-ations against the enemy from January, 1945, to September, 1945, During this period he par-ticipated in the assault land-ings on Lingayen, Zamboanga, Larakan and Bruner Bay. In addition, he successfully made a pre-assault reconnaissance of the landing beaches at Zambo-anga, Negros Island and Bruner

Bay. By his professional skill, devotion to duty and coolness under enemy fire, he contri-buted materially to the suc-cess of these amphibious land-ings. His performance through-out was in keeping with the highest traditions of the Navy of the United States. Son of Mr. and Mrs. Rollin Kachline, of Nazareth, he enlist-ed in the Navy, November, 1942. During his naval career he has served in both the Euro-pean and Pacific Theaters of War. He is now spending a 30-day leave at home with his parents.
