Wind Gap Sailor Receives Discharge

Seaman 2/C Ray Lesh, Wind Gap, was discharged yesterday from Bainbridge, Md. He is a son of Mr. and Mrs. L. O. Lesh, Lehigh Ave., Wind Gap. Mr. Lesh was graduated from Pen Argyl High School with the class of 1943. He enlisted in May, 1943, in the V-12 pre-flight program, and was transferred into the regular navy in November, 1944.

His naval training was taken at Sampson, N. Y., and Norfolk, Va. Early in 1945, his ship was one of those in the convoy which escorted the late President Roosevelt and other statesmen to the Yalta con-

ference. Prior to his discharge, he was stationed at the Philadelphia Navy Yard.

He was married to the former Dorothy Jones of Pen Argyl, in October, 1944, and they are at present residing in Pen Argyl.

His brother, M/Sgt. Nathan Lesh, is with the United States Army of Occupation in Munich, Germany. He was graduated from Pen Argyl High School with the class of 1939. He entered Lehigh University in September of the same year and graduated in June, 1943. The same month he enlisted in the service.
