Bath Soldier Reported Hurt On War Front

Word was received from Washington that Pvt. Raymond S. Snyder, Bath R. D. 2, near the Bath reservoir, was wounded in action in Italy March 30, according to a telegram received by Mrs. Snyder over the week-end.

Mrs. Snyder has since received a letter from a Red Cross worker who was with the unit stating that Snyder suffered a broken right hip and left leg.

He was inducted into the army December 26, 1942, and received his basic training at Camp Sibert, in Alabama. He was sent overseas April 1943, to North Africa. He was later in the invasion of Italy, and is in Italy since October 27, 1943.
