**Lieut. William Stump

After flying 70 hours in two-engined training planes and taking 70 lecture-hours of combat subjects in ground school, Lieut. Stump will be awarded silver wings of the Army Air Forces' pilot.

Lieut. Stump received his bachelor of science degree in chemical engineering before entering military service. He was assistant operations officer at Rapid City, S. D., before beginning his pilot training.
