Pvt. Grover Woodring, son of Mr. and Mrs. Oscar Woodring, 318 Northampton Street, Hellertown, is home for a brief visit, recuperating from wounds received in action in Italy. Surprised by a phone call from New York on Friday soon after Pvt. Woodring arrived there, his parents and his wife, the former Vivian Palmer, and their daughter, Carol Diane, twenty-months old, were delighted with his arrival home Saturday.

The soldier was wounded in Italy on June 28, while serving with an infantry unit. He was hospitalized in Europe for two months and then transported to New York, to which place he will return for further treatment.
