**Local Soldier Has
Swastika Torn From
Nazi Headquarters**

Sgt. Nicholas J. Theodoredis, a member of a Coast Artillery, Anti-Aircraft Battery, is the proud possessor of a swastika flag which he tore down from the wall of the headquarters building of the German 9th Panzer Division in Tunis.

Sgt. Theodoredis is home at the present time recuperating from malaria, and is stationed at the Aberdeen Proving Grounds, Maryland. He landed in Casablanca in September, 1942, and was on combat duty until his return a few months ago. Among other trophies are medals which decorated an Italian general.

While on overseas duty Sgt. Theodoredis wrote home saying he was not receiving his Globe-Times paper and several days later the family received another letter stating he received 50 back copies of the paper all at one time.

March 8, 1944
