Soldier Dies In Wales, Is Report to Wife

Staff Sergeant Nathan Sonnenfeld, U. S. Army, husband of the former Miss Hilda Norwood of 3 West Church Street, died "somewhere in Wales", according to information received by his wife on Saturday.

He died, according to the information, on February 15, and his wife received a letter from him on the same day. No further details

were given, but Mrs. Sonnenfeld will be informed by letter of the circumstances relating to his death.

His mother, Mrs. Anna Sonnenfeld of 710 East Fourth Street, has not been told of her son's death, and efforts are being made to keep the information from her.

He was inducted into the armed forces on April 19, 1941, and received his training in various army camps in the East. He has been overseas for the past six months.

He is survived by his wife, a son, Michael; his mother, three brothers, 2nd Lieut. Martin Sonnenfeld, U. S. Army Engineers, stationed in Kentucky; Sol. New York City; Julius, Bethlehem; and three sisters, Beatrice, New Britain, Conn.; Lillian and Bertie, at home.

A photo of Sergeant Sonnenfeld was published in today's issue of a Philadelphia newspaper, together with a native of the City of Brotherly Love. Both were shown operating a 60 m.m. mortar.
