Joyous news conveyed by shortwave broadcast from Germany brought to Mr. and Mrs. John Gaydos, of 621 Hillside Avenue, reassurance last evening that their son, Pvt. John Gaydos, Jr., 24, is alive and well in a prison camp in Germany.

Pvt. Gaydos, possessor of the Purple Heart, which is now in the hands of his family, was listed as missing. The broadcast picked up by

short wave radio broadcast, listing the name of her son as a German prisoner.
