Pvt. R. J. Milositz
Wounded In Action ^{JAN 24} 1945

Private Robert J. Milositz, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Milositz, 959 Wyandotte Street, reported wounded in action in France July 1, 1944, has arrived at the Halloran General Hospital, New York, and has informed his parents he will soon be sent to a local hospital for further treatment.

He trained at Fort Belvoir, Va., and Atlanta, Ga., before going overseas in November, 1943. Pvt. Milositz is a graduate of Bethlehem Technical High School and a member of the Holy Ghost Church. His brother, Pfc. Harold Milositz is serving in the South Pacific and a brother-in-law, George Gieger, is serving somewhere in France.
