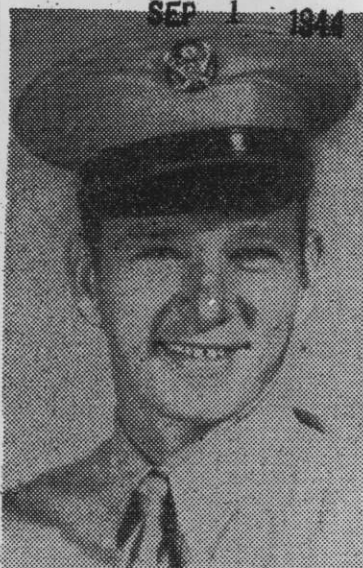


Zuk, Joseph

Sgt. Joseph Zuk, son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Zuk, 1460 Phillip Street, was reported for the second time as wounded in action, August 8, in France. The first telegram was received by the parents when he was in combat in Africa.

Sgt. Zuk received his training in Fort Wheeler, Ga., and Fort Bragg, N. C. He left Fort Dix in 1942 for overseas duty. Prior to entering the service, he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.
