Bremmer Cited



Corporal George A. Bremmer, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Bremmer, 614 South Bergen Street, has been awarded the Silver Star for gallantry in action on the Western front, according to a news dispatch from Europe. The accompanying citation read in part, "Cpl. Bremmer while serving as a liaison agent made two trips to enemy lines under fire, disregarding his own safety, and through his knowledge of the German language, persuaded seven enemy paratroopers to surrender." A graduate of Holy Ghost Parochial School and a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company, he entered the service in 1941. He trained at Fort Riley, Kan.; Camp Blanding, Fla., and Fort Jackson, S. C., before going overseas 18 months ago. A brother, Joseph Bremmer, was recently reported killed in action in Germany and another brother, John Jr., is completing his boot training at Sampson, N. Y.
